US Dept of Education website has developed two new e-tools: FAFSA 4castor @ www.federalstudentaid.ed.gov (provides an early eligibility estimate); COOL (College Opportunities Online Locator) @ www.ed.gov with an advance search on COOL. Provides quick search & info on colleges/universities/post-secondary inst.
5. Have teachers fill out **college recommendation forms**, available in guidance. **NOW !!** This will allow adequate time for the form to be completed and ready to be submitted with college applications.
6. **College Catalogues** are available for your overnight viewing. Stop by the guidance office and sign out a catalogues of your choice.
5. **College/Scholarship application suggestions:**
 - a. Check deadlines
 - b. Copy application and fill out the information on the copy first !!!
 - c. Transfer the information from the copy to the original application.
(Typed is recommended)
 - d. Bring completed application and fee (if required) to your guidance counselor to be checked, provided with supporting material and stamped mail envelope.
 - e. Allow **2 weeks prior to the postmarked deadline** for college applications to be processed by the guidance department.
